On July 26, 1990, President George H.W. Bush signed into law the Americans with Disabilities Act, guaranteeing equal opportunity for people with disabilities in public accommodations, commercial facilities, employment, transportation, schools, state and local government services and telecommunications.

393,816

The number of people in Iowa in 2021 report having a disability. They represent 12.5% of the civilian, noninstitutionalized population.

30.4%

Percentage of people 65 and older in 2021 with a disability, the highest of any age group.

32,300

Number of children under 18 in 2021 who have disabilities. This amounts to 4.4% of the population under 18 years of age.

166,900

The number of people aged 18-64 with a disability in 2021 or 10.4% of the population aged 18-64.

12.6%

The percent of males in Iowa in 2021 with a disability. This compares to 12.4% of females.

46.7%

The percent of households receiving food stamps which have one or more persons with a disability in 2021.

59,752

The number of households receiving food stamps which have one or more persons with a disability in 2021.

9,649

Number of Iowa grandparents with a disability living with grandchildren under 18 in 2021.

29.3%

Percentage of grandparents who are responsible for grandchildren under 18 in 2021 that have a disability.



Specific Disabilities

124,187

The number of lowans in 2021 reporting an inability to hear conversations or a serious hearing loss.

6.0%

Percentage of population age 5 and over with an ambulatory disability in 2021.

63,256

The number of lowans age 5 and over in 2021 who reported that a disability made it difficult to perform self-care activities such as dressing, bathing, or getting around inside the home.

124,296

The number of noninstitutionalized lowans age 18 and over in 2021 who reported an independent living disability that made it difficult to go outside the home alone to shop or visit a doctor's office.

68,119

The number of lowans of any age in 2021 who reported a disability of blindness or serious difficulty seeing even when wearing contacts or glasses.

151,297

Number of lowans in 2021 with limitations in cognitive functioning or who have a mental or emotional illness that interferes with daily activities, including those with Alzheimer's disease and intellectual disabilities. This included people with one or more problems that interfere with daily activities, such as frequently being depressed or anxious, trouble getting along with others, trouble concentrating and trouble coping with stress.

Veterans

46,726

Number of Iowa veterans in 2021 with a disability, representing 29.4% of Iowa veterans.



90,597

The number of Iowans age 18 to 64 in the labor force with a disability who were employed in 2021. 48.8% of Iowans in this age group, with a disability, worked at least part-time.

The unemployment rate in 2021 for Iowans with a disability. The unemployment rate in Iowa at that time was 3.6%

Percent of children under age 19 in Iowa that have a disability and are covered by insurance in 2021.

Percent of Iowans 19 to 64 years of age with a disability that had no health insurance coverage in 2021.
